## **HISTORY ON TRIAL** *My Day in Court with David Irving*

Deborah Lipstadt will analyze the major issues involved in her lawsuit in London and link them to the rise of **"NEW ANTISEMITISM."**

Deborah Lipstadt was the successful defendant in 2000 in a libel trial in London launched against her by the infamous David Irving who sued her for calling him a Holocaust denier and right wing extremist. The judge found Irving to be a Holocaust denier, a falsifier of history, a racist, an antisemite, and a liar. The trial was described by the *Daily Telegraph* (London) as having "done for the new century what the Nuremburg Tribunals or the Eichmann trial did for earlier generations." According to the *New York Times*, the trial "put an end to the pretense that Mr. Irving is anything but a self-promoting apologist for Hitler." In July 2001 the Court of Appeal resoundingly rejected Irving's attempt to appeal the judgment against him.
